Fee change from the turn of the year

The board has decided to increase the fee by 2% from the turn of the year. The long-term goal is not to increase the fees more than the KPI (consumer price index). However, fees for e.g. water and heating have been increased significantly more than the KPI. In order to balance the budget, the board has therefore been forced to increase the fee next year by more than the KPI.

The fee for parking spaces is being increased by 0.9%.

Bike clean-up and clean-up day
